




STEP 10

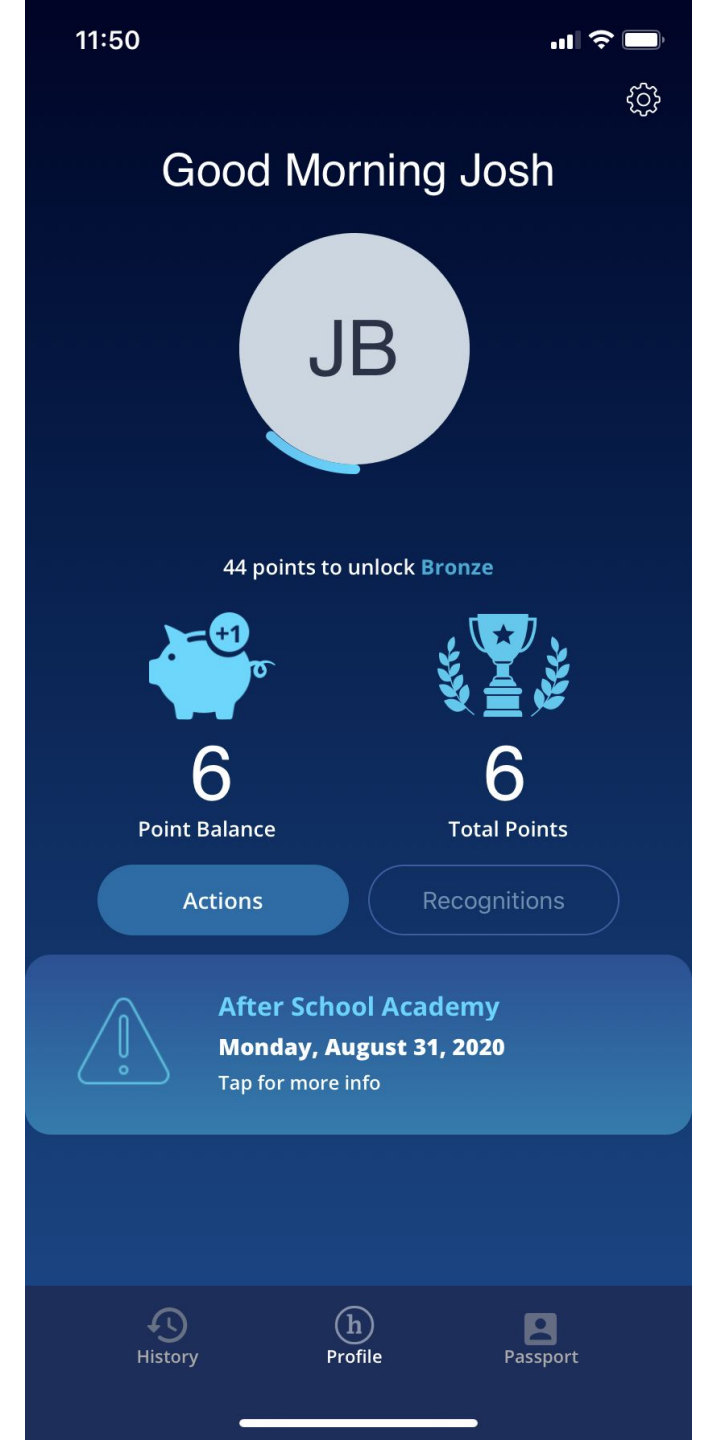
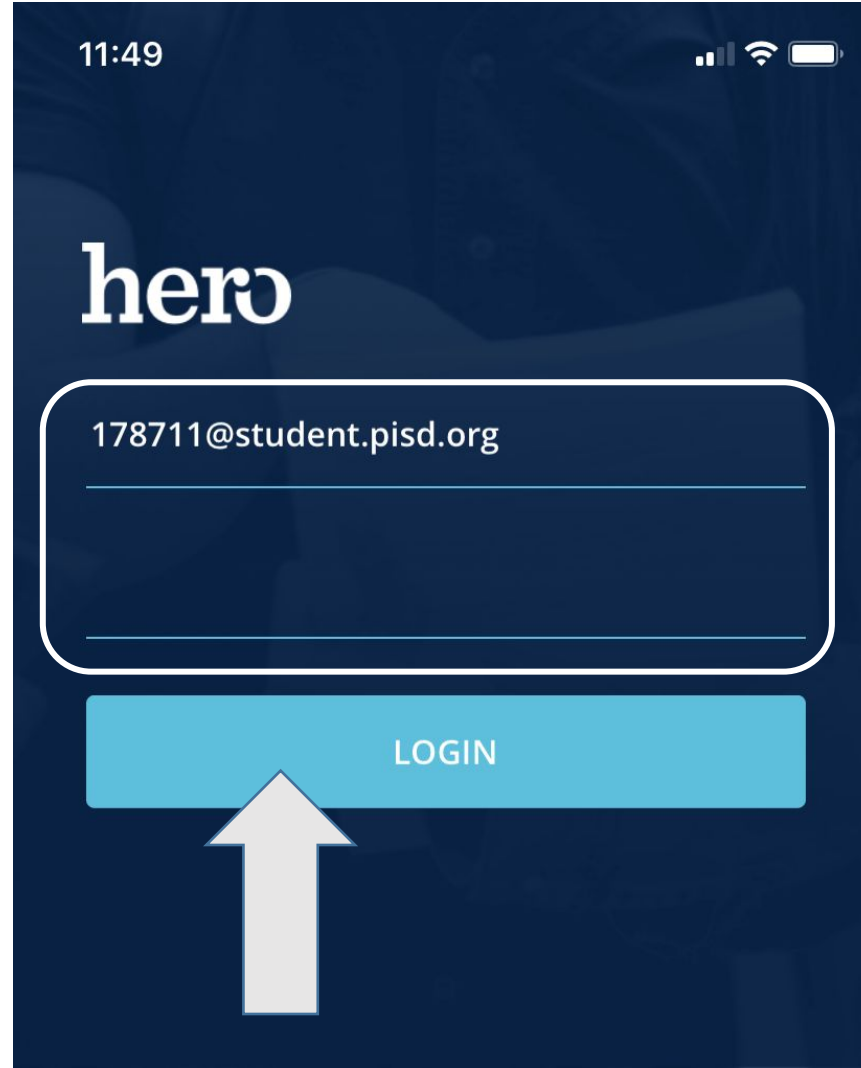
