Pharmacy Technician Program

The pharmacy technician program is designed for students to have classroom instruction and clinical experience in order to pass the certification test for a career in the health field. Space is LIMITED.

WHO IS THIS FOR?

Current 10th and 11th graders are eligible for this program. You should have an interest in a health related career and are committed to meeting ALL course requirements (instructional hours, clinical hours and fees).

PRE-REQUISITE RECOMMENDATIONS

Students interested in this program are highly recommended to be taking or have taken the following: an upper level math, biology, chemistry.

EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to meet the required hours by using after-school hours, weekends, holidays, etc.

- Instructional Hours = 145 hours (includes review sessions for the certification exam)
- Clinical Hours = 135 hours externship site and 25 online training

COSTS

- A deposit of \$200 for enrollment
- Background check: \$15
- Drug Test \$45.50

The additional fees listed below will be covered by the school.

- Tuition Cost, Textbook, Liability Insurance : \$2015
- Clinical Supplies (scrubs, patch, etc): \$35
