#5 Principal's Time	<p>Learning Design in Academies – Surveys have been used to obtain information on how to provide support for student learning.</p> <p>Over half of the staff had professional training over the summer.</p> <p>In the current environment, teachers are planning lessons in “weekly” chunks so that students are able to plan their work over the weeks’ time.</p> <p>There is a learning hub on campus for students who do not have internet access at home. Hot spots are also available for those without internet whose homes can get a signal.</p>
